## THUNDERFORCE'S SORRENTINO SETS NEW DB DRAG WORLD RECORD

Just one week after his ThunderForce teammate Jimmy Zimmerman bested the competition by 6.4 dB en route to a national and world record on the N.S.P.L. circuit, Steve Sorrentino took the dB Drag world by storm, setting a record of his own.

Sorrentino, of Johnston, Rhode Island, set a new world record of 174.6 dB in the Extreme 5-8 class at NOPI's "The Fast and the Furious" triple point dB Drag event at Maple Grove Raceway in Reading, PA.

Sorrentino, whose system fetaures five MTX RFL152 SPL competition subwoofers and 20 MTX Thunder 81000D amplifiers, defeated six other competitors in his class by scoring between 174.4 to 174.7 in five runs through the lanes.

"Anytime you come into a big event like this, your main objective is to be loud," states Sorrentino. "I've been loud all year and knew I had a chance to break the record. I really wanted to challenge myself to be consistent in my scores over time; two 174.6 and a 174.7, you can't ask for much more than that."

"I was one of the few guys who didn't spend my off time repairing woofers," Sorrentino adds. "Even at well over 174 dB, I used the same woofers, same cones through the entire competition."

Also finishing strong was Zimmerman, of Rocky Mount, North Carolina. Zimmerman won the Extreme 1-2 class with a final score of 173.3 dB. Zimmerman takes aim at the dB Drag world record in his class at next month's NOPI show in Pigeon Forge, TN.
