

INSTALLATION

1. Determine the mounting location for the MA8C speakers, ensuring there is adequate room for the speaker to sit flat on the mounting surface. Confirm that there is adequate clearance for the speaker basket in the intended mounting location, and there are no obstructions that will interfere with the back of the speaker or wiring when installed.
2. The MA8C requires a 6-3/4" diameter mounting hole. Mark the mounting hole in the intended mounting location, then double check for adequate clearance before cutting. Test fit the speaker and trim the mounting hole as needed.
3. Using the speaker as a template, mark the locations for the (6) mounting screws. Double check for adequate clearance, then drill 1/8" mounting holes.
4. Route the speaker and (optional) RGB wires through the mounting hole and connect to the terminals on the rear of the speaker using the included female spade connectors. The positive (+) speaker terminal requires the 0.25" (large) connector, the negative (-) speaker terminal requires the 0.187" (medium) connector, and the RGB terminals require the 0.110" (small) connectors. Observe proper speaker and RGB wiring polarity using the markings on the speaker basket next to each terminal.
5. Install speaker into the mounting location making sure that the wiring is routed away from the mounting holes for the screws. Align the speaker with the mounting holes, then insert and partially tighten the (6) included mounting screws.
6. Once all mounting screws have been started, tighten until the speaker is snug in place and the foam gasket on the back of the speaker basket sits flat against the mounting surface. Do not over tighten the screws.

Customize the Look

If you wish to customize the look of your speakers, the silver grille overlay can be removed and painted to match the vehicle color scheme. Remove the grille overlay from the speaker assembly before painting as shown in Figure 1 below.



WIRING

1. Connect the speaker wires to your amplifier ensuring correct polarity, positive (+) and negative (-).
2. The MA8C includes RGB speaker illumination. When hard-wiring the RGB lighting, the Black lead is +12V and the Red, Green, and Blue leads are ground. There are seven colors available, depending on the wiring configuration. MTX recommends using the **MUDLEDC** remote control (*sold separately*) for more colors, patterns and special effects.

Color Wiring Options	
Grounded Wire(s)	LED Color Output
Red	Red
Green	Green
Blue	Blue
Red / Green	Lime Green
Red / Blue	Magenta
Green / Blue	Aquamarine
Red / Green / Blue	Blue-White

Connect the colored wires on the left to make output colors on the right.



The MUDLEDC is a remote control and wiring control harness that is designed to work with a variety of RGB LED enabled MTX products.


